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## INTRODUCTION

### ○ ***Location:***

Baptist Christian Hospital is situated on the North Bank of the river Brahmaputra in Tezpur, Assam in the North Eastern region of India. Tezpur is the Headquarter of Sonitpur District of Assam and the most important town. Tezpur is 250 km (4 hours) east of Dispur, which is the Capital of the state of Assam. Guwahati is the nearest railhead and airport. Baptist Christian Hospital is located just four kilometers from the main town of Tezpur. The nursing school is located within the Hospital Premises.

### ○ ***About Baptist Christian Hospital, Tezpur:***

The Baptist Christian Hospital, Tezpur is a 120-bedded hospital that is situated in the Sonitpur district of Assam. The hospital was established in 1954. The Baptist Christian Hospital, Tezpur is a charitable hospital registered as a society under the Society Registration Act of India; 1860. The hospital has been serving the poor and the marginalized communities in the area and the surrounding districts including three districts of the state of Arunachal Pradesh. The hospital is a unit of the Emmanuel Hospital Association, New Delhi. The Emmanuel Hospital Association is one of the largest non-governmental health care providers of the country. EHA manages and owns 20 hospitals, 42 community health projects, 7 nursing school in North, Central and North East India.

Miss Arlene Jenson and Miss Betty Pierson, Christian Missionaries from Baptist General Conference (BGC) USA, founded the School of Nursing, Baptist Christian Hospital in April 1954. There were six students in the first batch. The hospital was officially opened in June 1954. The General Nursing and Midwifery program is a recognized course by the Assam Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council.

5. All information given in the application form should be correct. Any false certificates/ information in the application would lead to disqualification. If the same is discovered during the course of training, the candidate will be liable to be terminated.
6. Completed application form along with necessary enclosures should be sent to the Principal so as to reach **on or before 31<sup>st</sup> July '2020, at 5:00 PM.**
7. Incomplete applications will be rejected.

○ ***Description of G.N.M. Training Program:***

The General Nursing and Midwifery program is a 3-year course. The student on completion of the G.N.M. program will develop skills in providing preventive, promotive, curative and rehabilitative services to the hospital and community. **2- Eligibility Criteria:**

- a. 10+2 pass preferably science with (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) & English with an aggregate of 40 % marks.
- b. 10+2 pass with Arts & English with an aggregate of 40% marks.
- c. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from a school recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
- d. Registered ANM with pass mark.
- e. The Minimum age should be 17 years.
- f. Should be medically fit to undergo the course.



**3- Number of seats:** 30 (Thirty)

**4- Reservation:**

For disabled candidates: 3% disability reservation.

**5- Selection Process (Entrance Examination & Interview):**

- i. Applicants fulfilling the admission criteria will be called for entrance examination to the School of Nursing, Baptist Christian Hospital at their own expense. The date for the same will be informed through phone.
- ii. Selection will be made on the basis of entrance examination and interview. The entrance examination will be of 3 hours' duration which will include questions from the following areas:
  - Biology
  - Chemistry
  - Physics
  - Mathematics
  - English
  - Aptitude and General Knowledge
- iii. Shortlisted candidates will be notified on the same day.
- iv. The candidates clearing the entrance examination will be called for interview.
- v. Final list of the selected candidates will be released on the same day.
- vi. Selected candidate will have to submit letter of acceptance to the Principal, School of Nursing to take up the course.

**6- Rejection and Disqualification:**

An application will be rejected if:

- a) Received after 31<sup>st</sup> July'2020.
- b) Application form is incomplete/wrongly filled in.
- c) Certificates and testimonials are found to be inaccurate or false.
- d) Documents are incomplete.

- e) Failing to take the Entrance Exam.
- f) Failing to present original certificates and testimonials at the time of Interview.

#### **7- Admission:**

- i. The selected candidates will be admitted on the same day after selection.
- ii. Letter mentioning the selection of fee **option should be given to the Principal.**
- iii. Candidates selected for admission will be required to pay 50% of the 1<sup>st</sup> year fee (Academic and Mess) and to complete other necessary admission formalities.
- iv. **Admission will remain cancelled if the student fails to deposit 50% of the Academic fee and Mess fee.**
- v. Candidates opting for **SUBSIDIZED FEE** will have to sign a service agreement for two years with the Baptist Christian Hospital, Tezpur.
- vi. Hostel allotment will be in the month of October' 2020.
- vii. Classes will begin from October'2020.
- viii. Selected candidates will have to clear the first term examination which will be held after 3 months of the admission to continue the course.
- ix. Candidates who do not clear the final council exam will be held back for six months and will have to get admission for that said year.
- x. **No candidate will be allowed to appear for exam without clearing the fees.**
- xi. Fees should be paid at the beginning of every academic year i.e. October as per the fee structure (II Year & III year).

#### **8- Examination Board:**

School of Nursing, Baptist Christian Hospital is affiliated to the Assam Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitor Council and is recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi.

### ***9- Pre-Clinical Period:***

The first three months of training program is assessment period, at the end of which first term examination is held to evaluate the student's ability to continue the course. Minimum 50% marks in each subject is required to continue the course.

### ***10- Hostel:***

Hostel accommodation and food is provided to all students as this is a residential program. All students will have to stay in the hostel provided and will have to abide by the hostel rules and regulations.

### ***11- Mess facilities:***

The hostel is provided with a mess that provides nutritious and fresh food every day. It is compulsory for all students to eat the food provided in the hostel.

### ***12- Campus Activities:***

Various campus activities are provided for the students, such as facilities for recreation, social and professional gatherings, picnics and field trips. Many opportunities are available for spiritual growth & fellowship like Sunday worship services, Bible studies, Youth Fellowship, Retreat and special meetings are organized from time to time.

### ***13- Health Care:***

- a. All students are expected to be fully immunized before joining the course.
- b. Annual health checkup is compulsory for all the students.
- c. Students are encouraged to live healthier.
- d. Students Health Scheme will be as per the institution policy.
  - Consultation charges will be free.
  - 40% of the cost of medication
  - 40% of other IP treatment bills
  - 20% of surgery procedure rate implants (except dental)
- e. Dental Implants, Cosmetic treatments and Orthodontics care are available and will be a paid facility.
- f. **Any cost of major illness requiring referral of the student to a higher center will be borne by the parent/guardian.**

#### **14- Uniform:**

##### **a. For female students:**

- i.** Mustard color scrub, with badge and identity card.
- ii.** Black cardigan for winter.
- iii.** Black shoes with white socks.

##### **b. For male students:**

- i.** Mustard color scrub with badge and identity card.
- ii.** Black sweater for winter.
- iii.** Black shoes with white socks.

##### **c. For community posting:**

###### **i. Female students:**

Salwar (Ash color), with badge and identity card. Black shoes with white socks. Black cardigan during winter.

###### **ii. Male students:**

Shirt (Ash color), black trousers with badge and Identity card. Black shoes with white socks. Black sweater during winter.

**The Uniform will be provided by the School but Students should bring black cardigan (Sweater), black shoes and white socks at the time of joining.**

#### **15- Syllabus & Examination:**

- a.** Syllabus is as laid down by the Indian Nursing Council and Assam Nurses Midwives and Health Visitors Council.
- b.** Examinations are held annually by Assam Nurses Midwives and Health Visitor's Council. Internal exams are held prior to the Board exams and it is necessary to obtain a **minimum of 50%** marks in each subject (theory & practical) to be eligible to appear for the Council Exam. Weekly/Monthly tests are held for each subject.
- c.** Internal examinations are held in the month prior to the external examinations.

#### ***16- Leave and Vacation:***

- i. Vacation:** Four weeks of vacation for I Year and II year. For III year only two weeks of vacation as per the syllabus.
- ii. Sick Leave:**  
A maximum of 10 days' sick leave per year is allowed. If a student is sick for more than 40 days (including 30 days of vacation + 10 days of sick leave), He/She will be eligible to sit for exams at a later date and the period of training will be extended.
- iii. Weekly Day off:** One day every week.
- iv. Preparatory Leaves:** 7 days
- v. National Holidays:** 6 days

#### ***17- Salient Rules of Nursing School:***

- i.** All Students are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the Nursing School and the Hostel, failing to which appropriate disciplinary action will be taken. A level of professional standards is expected from the students.
- ii.** Students should attend clinical and classes on time.
- iii.** Visiting any family quarters without prior permission is prohibited. Permission must be obtained from the Principal of Nursing School.
- iv.** At the time of admission, parents/guardian must give a list of visitors they would allow their ward to meet. Frequent visits are not encouraged.
- v.** The Principal holds the right to open any parcel/letter coming to the students and to deal with them accordingly.

#### ***18- Anti-Ragging Resolution:***

- i.** The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India order for implementation of Anti Ragging Recommendation of the Lyngdoh Committee – 02.04.2008 and UGC REGULATION, 2009 – 14.12.2009, is implemented strictly.
- ii.** It is declared that any student, if found guilty of ragging, will be terminated from the course.

***19- Discontinuation of Training:***

- i. NO FEES WILL BE REFUNDED IF THE STUDENT DISCONTINUES THE COURSE.**
- ii.** Students discontinuing the training will be required to pay fee for entire duration of the course (i.e. I year, II year & III year) to the Nursing school.
- iii.** Any student getting married during the course will be asked to discontinue the training.
- iv.** Any students not abiding with the rules and regulations will be terminated.

c) ***Fees and other expenses:***

- i. Fees once paid will not be refunded in any circumstances.
- ii. Academic Fees for the whole course i.e. three years can be paid in one installment
- iii. Mess fee is subject to be revised every year based on the inflation rates.
- iv. Fees should be paid at the beginning of every academic year i.e. October as per the fee structure to continue the next session.
- v. **Late fee of Rs.500/ month will be charged if the amount is not paid on time.**
- vi. **Fees can be paid in three instalments:**
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Instalment at the time of admission 50%
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Instalment- March 25%
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Instalment –July remaining 25%

○ ***Service agreement:***

All candidate admitted to the course by opting to pay **subsidized fee** are required to sign a service agreement in lieu of financial subsidy with the Baptist Christian Hospital at the time of admission. After successful completion of the training, the student opting subsidized fee will have to serve for a minimum period of two years in any of the **EHA (Emmanuel Hospital Association)** hospitals.

***Violation of service commitment agreement:***

Candidates who avails subsidized fee and fails to comply with the service agreement after completion of the nursing course will be liable to pay a sum of Rs.1500000/- (Rupees Fifteen lakh only) to the Baptist Christian Hospital and will forfeit the right to employment or further studies in any of the EHA hospitals and its sister concerns.
